This month our Book List features some individual volumes of R. R. Donnelley's *The Lakeside Classics*. Specifically, we want to feature volumes included in the "Red" series of Lakesides, covering the years 1928-1952. The publishers of *The Lakeside Classics* sought to create fine and desirable volumes to present to employees and customers as annual Christmas gifts. They were never sold in stores. The project continued from 1903 through 2018. The books are bound in various colors of cloth with each color running in a series of 25 years. While books from the initial "Green" series are the most sought-after by collectors, the reds can also be hard to find, especially before the heavier print runs of the blue and brown series'.


In the introduction to the series printed in THE AUTOBIOGRAPHY OF BENJAMIN FRANKLIN (1903), the publishers give their philosophy behind their effort to give out fine, handsomely printed, but useful books as Christmas gifts. "...this volume stands for the machine-made book. Its paper, its type-setting, its presswork, and its binding all are the product of the very latest labor-saving machines. It aims to be readable rather than eccentric, plain rather than decorative, tasteful rather than unique, useful rather than useless; withal, to hold the essence of the of the old masters of book-making, and not to copy the mechanical shortcomings which they themselves strove so hard to overcome."
